SATURDAY 11 APRIL (LAZARUS SATURDAY)

•Divine Liturgy : 8.00am

Lazarus was raised from the dead by our Lord. The Church names this day the "Saturday of Lazarus" in remembrance of the resurrection of Lazarus and its promise of universal resurrection for all men.

•Great Vespers (Palm Sunday Vespers) : 5.00pm

SUNDAY 12 APRIL (PALM SUNDAY)

•Divine Liturgy : 7.30am

Jesus enters Jerusalem as King and the people lay palm branches along the road to greet Him. We receive palm branches on this day to acknowledge that we accept Jesus as our King.

•Evening Service of the Bridegroom (ΤΟΥ ΝΥΜΦΙΟΥ) : 6.00pm

Christ, the Bridegroom (Ο ΝΥΜΦΙΟΣ); the blessed Joseph; the Barren Fig Tree.

MONDAY 13 APRIL (HOLY WEEK BEGINS)

•Evening Service of the Bridegroom (ΤΟΥ ΝΥΜΦΙΟΥ) : 6.00pm – Parable of the Ten Virgins.

TUESDAY 14 APRIL

•Pre-Sanctified Divine Liturgy : 8.00am

In this ancient and inspired service, we receive Holy Communion which was consecrated at the Divine Liturgy on the previous Sunday

•Evening Service of the Bridegroom (ΤΟΥ ΝΥΜΦΙΟΥ) : 6.00pm

We remember the sinful woman who anointed Christ, in anticipation of His death.

*Her repentance and love for Christ are the theme of the **Hymn of Cassiane**, chanted this night.*

WEDNESDAY 15 APRIL (Christ's betrayal by Judas Iscariot)

•The Sacrament of Holy Unction : 4.30pm

The priest anoints us with Holy Oil (Ευχέλαιον) so that we may be spiritually and physically healed.

•Followed by Matins of Holy Thursday.

THURSDAY 16 APRIL (The Mystic Supper)

•Divine Liturgy : 8.00am

•The Service of the Passion of our Lord : 6.00pm

The Twelve Readings from the Gospels during which the Crucifix is carried to the front of the altar by the priest.

These selected narratives from the four Gospels, relate to the events of Christ's Holy Passion (ΠΑΘΟΣ) and His last instructions to the twelve disciples.

FRIDAY 17 APRIL (HOLY FRIDAY) (Christ's Crucifixion, Death and Burial)

•The Service of the Great Hours : 7.00am followed by

•Great Vespers and the Taking down of the Body of Christ from the Cross (ΑΠΟΚΑΘΗΛΩΣΙΣ)

The priest takes down Christ's Body from the Cross, wraps it in a white cloth (shroud) and then places it in the Altar, as a symbol of His Burial by Joseph of Arimathea.

•The Service of Lamentations (ΕΥΚΩΜΙΑ) : 6.00pm

The mourning of Christ's undeserved death to save us from our sins, followed by the procession of the Epitaphion (within the Church) symbolizing our Lord's Burial.

SATURDAY 18 APRIL (Christ's descent to Hades, and His Holy Resurrection)

•Divine Liturgy and Service of the Pre-Announcement of the Resurrection : 8.00am

•Service and Divine Liturgy of the Resurrection : 11.00pm

At midnight, in the darkened church, the faithful receive Holy Light (ΑΓΙΟ ΦΩΣ) from the priest. The congregation hears the good news of Christ's triumph; His victory over death, from the Gospel. The joyous hymn of Christ's Resurrection is triumphantly chanted – "Christ is Arisen!" (ΧΡΙΣΤΟΣ ΑΝΕΣΤΗ!) The Divine Liturgy of the Resurrection follows.

MONDAY 20 APRIL : Divine Liturgy : 7.30am

TUESDAY 21 APRIL : Divine Liturgy : 7.30am - Commemorating Saints Raphael, Nicholas and Irene

THURSDAY 23 APRIL : Divine Liturgy : 7.30am - Commemorating St George, Great-Martyr the Trophy Bearer

FRIDAY 24 APRIL : Divine Liturgy : 7.30am - Commemorating Miracle of the Life-Giving Spring
