ST VASILIOS SERVICES—HOLY WEEK/PASCHA 2025

SATURDAY 12 APRIL (LAZARUS SATURDAY)

•Divine Liturgy: 7.30am

Lazarus was raised from the dead by our Lord. The Church names this day the "Saturday of Lazarus" in remembrance of the resurrection of Lazarus and its promise of universal resurrection for all men.

SUNDAY 13 APRIL (PALM SUNDAY)

●Divine Liturgy: 7.30am

Jesus enters Jerusalem as King and the people lay palm branches along the road to greet Him.

We receive palm branches on this day to acknowledge that we accept Jesus as our King.

•Evening Service of the Bridegroom (ΤΟΥ ΝΥΜΦΙΟΥ) : 6.00pm

Christ, the Bridegroom (O NYM Φ IO Σ); the blessed Joseph; the Barren Fig Tree.

MONDAY 14 APRIL (HOLY WEEK BEGINS)

Pre-Sanctified Divine Liturgy: 8.00am

In this ancient and inspired service, we receive Holy Communion which was consecrated at the Divine Liturgy on the previous Sunday

•Evening Service of the Bridegroom (TOY NYMΦIOY): 6.00pm - Parable of the Ten Virgins.

TUESDAY 15 APRIL

Pre-Sanctified Divine Liturgy: 8.00am

Evening Service of the Bridegroom (ΤΟΥ ΝΥΜΦΙΟΥ) : 6.00pm

We remember the sinful woman who anointed Christ, in anticipation of His death.

Her repentance and love for Christ are the theme of the **Hymn of Cassiane**, chanted this night.

WEDNESDAY 16 APRIL (Christ's betrayal by Judas Iscariot)

Pre-Sanctified Divine Liturgy: 8.00am

•The Sacrament of Holy Unction, : 5.00pm

The priest anoints us with Holy Oil (Ευχέλαιον) so that we APRIL be spiritually and physically healed.

•Followed by Matins of Holy Thursday.

THURSDAY 17 APRIL (The Mystic Supper)

•Divine Liturgy: 7.00am—presided by His Grace Bishop Eumenios of Kerasountos

•The Service of the Passion of our Lord : 6.00pm

The Twelve Readings from the Gospels during which the Crucifix is carried to the front of the altar by the priest.

These selected narratives from the four Gospels, relate to the events of Christ's Holy Passion ($\Pi A\Theta O \Sigma$) and His last instructions to the twelve disciples.

FRIDAY 18 APRIL (HOLY FRIDAY) (Christ's Crucifixion, Death and Burial)

•The Service of the Great Hours: 8.00am

Great Vespers and the Taking down of the Body of Christ from the Cross (ΑΠΟΚΑΘΗΛΩΣΙΣ): 3.00pm

The priest takes down Christ's Body from the Cross, wraps it in a white cloth (shroud) and then places it in the Altar, as a symbol of His Burial by Joseph of Arimathea.

•The Service of Lamentations (ΕΥΚΩΜΙΑ): 7.00pm

The mourning of Christ's undeserved death to save us from our sins, followed by the procession of the Epitaphion symbolizing our Lord's Burial.

SATURDAY 19 APRIL (Christ's descent to Hades, and His Holy Resurrection)

•Divine Liturgy and Service of the Pre-Announcement of the Resurrection: 7.00am

•Service and Divine Liturgy of the Resurrection: 11.00pm

At midnight, in the darkened church, the faithful receive Holy Light (AΓΙΟ $\Phi\Omega\Sigma$) from the priest. The congregation hears the good news of Christ's triumph; His victory over death, from the Gospel. The joyous hymn of Christ's Resurrection is triumphantly chanted – "Christ is Arisen!" (XPIΣΤΟΣ ΑΝΕΣΤΗ!) The Divine Liturgy of the Resurrection follows.

SUNDAY 20 APRIL (HOLY PASCHA)

11.00am Great Paschal Vespers of Agape

At Axion Esti, Northcote, headed by His Grace Bishop Eumenios of Kerasountos and participated by the clergy of Melbourne.

(Bible passage is read in many languages representing the universality of our Lord's Resurrection.)

MONDAY 21 APRIL: Divine Liturgy: 7.30am

TUESDAY 22 APRIL: Divine Liturgy: 7.30am - Commemorating Saints Raphael, Nicholas and Irene

WEDNESDAY 23 APRIL: Divine Liturgy: 7.30am - Commemorating St George, Great-Martyr

FRIDAY 25 APRIL: Divine Liturgy: 7.30am - Commemorating Miracle of the Life-Giving Spring
